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Importer Security Filing (10+2) Consent Form

Effective January 26, 2009, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) requires an Importer Security Filing (ISF) 24 hrs prior to ocean vessel loading at foreign ports. This ISF filing is separate from and in addition to the existing advance cargo declaration (24 hr Rule) and Customs entry requirements.

If an Importer fails to timely, accurately, and completely submit the Importer Security Filing, a monetary penalty will be assessed for liquidation damages per shipment, effective Jan 26, 2010.

PLEASE NOTE: There can be only one ISF filer per shipment.

South East World Wide (Chicago) Ltd, as your logistics service provider, is capable of, and have the ability to transmit ISF data on your behalf.

- As the ISF Importer, you must alert your suppliers that the SEWW Origin Offices will request information necessary to file the ISF by the document cut-off date. In order to avoid cargo delay or penalties, your documents (Invoice and Packing List) must be delivered to SEWW at the Port of Export no later than 72 hours before document cut-off date.

U.S. Customs may require an ISF bond, effective January 26, 2010. A final decision is pending. Importers are required to have a Customs bond. If you do not have a bond, we can obtain it for you.
